We want to maximize traffic to your booth!

Promotional exposure to attendees

- Because of Covid, the 2023 conference is the first in-person conference in 4 years.

Good neighbor policy

We will observe a “good neighbor” policy at the trade show. This ensures all exhibitors and attendees have a clear view of booths from the main aisles.

- From the aisle, the first 2 feet of space is limited to 4 feet in height for solid display material.
- After the initial 2 feet from the aisle, there are no height restrictions.

Is the trade show open to the public?

Yes, on Tuesday and Wednesday.

Garden Thyme Marketplace Vendor Agreement

This Agreement is between Johnson County Extension Master Gardener Association and vendor to operate a booth at the Garden Thyme Marketplace Trade Show during the 2023 International Master Gardener Conference.

The 2023 International Master Gardener Conference will be held from June 18 through noon June 22, 2023, at the Overland Park Convention Center at 6000 College Blvd, Overland Park, Kansas.

Vendor Move In:

- Sunday, June 18th 2:00 pm to 7:00 pm; or
- Monday, June 19th 8:00 to 11:00 am

Trade Show Hours:

- Monday, June 19th Noon to 7:00 pm
- Tuesday June 20th 10:00 to 7:00 pm
- Wednesday, June 21st 10:00 am to 7:00 pm

Vendor Move Out:

- Wednesday, June 21st after 7:00 pm to 9:00 pm; or
- Thursday, June 22nd 8:00 am to noon.
- Booth assignment and location at the Trade Show will be at the discretion of the Johnson County Extension Master Gardeners. Payment in full is required to guarantee booth space.
- Vendor agrees to have booth setup completed before the Trade Show opening (June 19th at noon). Vendor agrees to not begin booth teardown until after completion of the Trade Show (June 21st at 7 pm).
- Vendor agrees to maintain a neat and tidy booth for the duration of the Trade Show event and to follow all rules of the Convention Center. All vendor materials will be confined within the booth area keeping all aisles clear.
- Vendor will not mar, deface or damage any part of the Trade Show facility and will leave the vending area used in as good condition and repair as at the beginning of the Trade Show. Vendor is responsible for any damage in its vending area.
- Vendor agrees to staff their booth during all posted Trade Show event hours. There is no guarantee of attendance.
- Vendor is solely responsible for collection and reporting of all Kansas sales tax for items sold during the Trade Show event.
- If vendor requires water, electrical or other special services, vendor is responsible for ordering and paying for the services. (2023 fees and services not available as of 3-22)
- Although the Trade Show area will be secured during off hours, vendor is responsible for securing its merchandise.
- Vendor agrees to hold the Johnson County Extension Master Gardener Association and the Overland Park Convention Center harmless and blameless and will make no claim for any reason, for loss, theft, damage or destruction of property, or for any injury to it or its employees, agents, or invitees.
- Vendor may cancel their participation prior to March 1, 2023, with a \$50 cancellation fee. Cancellations after March 1, 2023, will forfeit the booth vending fee.
- Vendor agrees to all the above terms and conditions by signature below.
